### R E S O L V E

Providing additional compensation to the Doorkeepers, Assistant-Doorkeepers and Messengers of the Senate and House of Representatives.

*Resolved*, That in addition to the compensation provided in chapter seven of the acts of the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two, there be allowed and paid out of the treasury, to each of the doorkeepers, assistant-doorkeepers and messengers of the senate and house of representatives, the sum of one hundred and thirty-five dollars, for their services for the full session of the present session of the legislature, and in like proportion for any part of the session.
