Providing for certain expenses incurred at the Militia Camp

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of the treasury, and the same is hereby appropriated, a sum not exceeding one thousand five hundred and ten dollars and eighty cents, for expenses incurred in grading and draining the militia camp grounds at Framingham; payments to be made upon vouchers approved by the governor and council.
