AN ACT

To amend an Act to enable the First Congregational Society in the town of Falmouth, to dispose of certain Real Estate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section second of chapter eighty-three of private
2 and special statutes of one thousand eight hun-
3 dred and twenty-four, is so far amended as to
4 allow said society, at any legal meeting called for
5 that purpose, to appropriate any part of the pro-
6 ceeds arising from the sale of said lands to the
7 building or purchase, and maintenance, of a parson-
8 age to be kept for the use of the minister of said
9 society.
