AN ACT

In addition to an Act establishing the City of
Salem.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECT. 1. The annual election in the city of
2 Salem, which is now by law held on the first Mon-
3 day of January, shall in future be held on the
4 second Tuesday of December.

1 SECT. 2. The annual organization of the city
2 government shall take place on the first Monday
3 of January, and that of the school committee as
4 soon thereafter as may be practicable.

1 SECT. 3. All the provisions of an act establish-
2 ing the city of Salem, and the acts additional
3 thereto, inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.
