AN ACT

To amend Chapter twenty-eight of the General Statutes, relating to Cemetery Lots.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section three of chapter twenty-eight of the
2 General Statutes is hereby amended by inserting
3 after the word "privileges," in the third line of
4 said section, the words: "If such proprietor shall
5 leave a widow, she shall be entitled to the same
6 rights and privileges in such lots as though she
7 were an heir at law of such proprietor."
