AN ACT

To amend an Act entitled an Act to annex a portion of the Town of Sharon to the Town of Walpole.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECT. 1. The town of Sharon is hereby author-
2 ized to collect the taxes for the present year on
3 that portion of the town of Sharon set off to said
4 town of Walpole by chapter two hundred and
5 twelve of the acts of the year eighteen hundred
6 and seventy-four, for its own use and benefit.

1 SECT. 2. The town of Sharon shall, for the
2 the present year, at its own expense, keep the
3 roads and bridges in said portion of its territory
4 set off to Walpole, in good order and condition;
5 and shall also pay the amount of state and county
6 taxes levied on the assessed valuation of said por-
7 tion of territory set off as aforesaid, when the
8 same becomes payable.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
