Resolved, That the unexpended balance of the appropriation authorized by chapter sixty-nine of the resolves of the year eighteen hundred and seventy-five for the enlargement of the state reform school for boys at Westborough, amounting to nineteen thousand four hundred eighty-nine dollars and ninety-one cents, be and hereby is reappropriated, to be expended for the purposes and in the manner specified in said resolve.
