### AN ACT

To amend Chapter fifty-six of the Acts of the Year eighteen hundred and thirty-six, relative to the Alewife Fishing in the Town of Wellfleet.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The second section of chapter fifty-six of the  
2 acts of the year eighteen hundred and thirty-six  
3 is hereby amended by inserting after the words  
4 "through which said streams run," and before the  
5 words "without being deemed trespassers" the  
6 words "and may deposit the dirt and obstructions  
7 so removed upon the border of said land or  
8 meadow."
