RESOLVE

In favor of the Massachusetts School for Idiotic and Feeble-minded Youth.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid to the Massachusetts School for Idiotic and Feeble-minded Youth, the sum of twenty-five hundred dollars, to meet the wants of the school in its current and necessary expenses, and the further sum of six thousand dollars, to pay for special and extraordinary repairs upon the buildings during the past year.
