AN ACT

To amend an Act entitled an Act to incorporate the
Massachusetts Anglers' Association.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECT. 1. The Massachusetts Anglers' Associa-
2 tion shall hereafter be known by the name of The
3 Massachusetts Fish and Game Protective Asso-
4 ciation.

1 SECT. 2. Section one of chapter sixty-six of the
2 acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, is here-
3 by amended by striking out all after the words
4 "and killing of," in the eighth line thereof, and
5 inserting the following: "And game, fish, shell-
6 fish and bivalves; the promotion of the culture of
7 game and fish, and the introduction of new species
8 and varieties of game and fish, and to disseminate
9 information relating thereto."

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
