### RESOLVE

In favor of George White.

*Resolved,* That there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth to George White, probate judge of Norfolk County, the sum of one hundred and ninety-three dollars and fifty-five cents for performing the duties of probate judge of Suffolk County during the vacancy caused by the death of Isaac Ames, probate judge of said Suffolk County, and the appointment of his successor in the month of March, in the year eighteen hundred and seventy-seven.
