### AN ACT

In addition to an Act, entitled "An Act to incorporate Jonathan Gardner, Jun., and others therein named, into a Society by the Name of the Marine Society of Salem, in the County of Essex, in the Province of the Massachusetts Bay, in New England."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. That so much of the act passed  
2 in seventeen hundred and seventy-two, entitled  
3 "An Act to incorporate Jonathan Gardner, jun.,  
4 and others therein named, into a society by the  
5 name of the Marine Society at Salem," as relates  
6 to the monthly meetings of said society be and  
7 hereby is repealed; and that said society shall,  
8 and hereby are empowered to hold such meetings

9 of said society, for the purpose of electing officers  
10 and committees, admitting members, altering by-  
11 laws and transacting any business legally coming  
12 before them, as they by their by-laws shall in  
13 future establish and appoint.

1    SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
