### AN ACT

To authorize the Arlington Mills to increase its  
Capital Stock.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The Arlington Mills, a corpora-  
2 tion located in the city of Lawrence, may increase  
3 its capital stock to an amount not exceeding one  
4 million five hundred thousand dollars, subject to  
5 the provisions of the general laws regulating the  
6 payment of capital stock.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
