AN ACT

Relating to Probate Courts in the County of
Plymouth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. There shall be held in each year,
2 within and for the county of Plymouth, a probate
3 court at Wareham in the county of Plymouth on
4 the fourth Monday of August.

1 SECT. 2. The probate court, now provided to
2 be held at Middleborough in said county of
3 Plymouth on the fourth Monday of August, is
4 hereby discontinued, and all processes and matters
5 returnable to the probate court to be held at said
6 Middleborough on the fourth Monday of August,
7 may be heard and acted upon at the probate court
8 hereby authorized to be held at said Wareham.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
