AN ACT

To amend the Charter of the Housatonic Water Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter two hundred and sixty-
2 two of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and
3 eighty-four, "An Act to incorporate the Housa-
4 tonic Water Company," is hereby amended by
5 striking out the whole of section six and substi-
6 tuting therefor the following:—
7 *Sect. 6.* The said corporation may, for the
8 purposes set forth in this act, hold real estate not
9 exceeding in amount fifteen thousand dollars, and
10 the whole capital stock of said corporation shall
11 not exceed forty thousand dollars, to be divided
12 into shares of one hundred dollars each.

1 SECT. 2. Section eleven is hereby amended by
2 striking out the word "three," in the third line of
3 said section, and substituting therefor the word
4 "five."

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
