AN ACT

Relating to the Expense of Recording Probate Proceedings in the County of Suffolk.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The expense of recording probate
2 proceedings in the county of Suffolk, regulated
3 by section forty-four of chapter one hundred and
4 fifty-six of the Public Statutes, shall not exceed
5 twenty-eight hundred dollars in any one year.
6 So much of said section forty-four as is inconsis-
7 tent with this act is hereby repealed.

1 SECT. 2. Chapter one hundred and eighteen
2 of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and
3 eighty-four is hereby repealed.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
