AN ACT

To establish the Rates of Pilotage for the Ports of Salem and Beverly.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The rates of pilotage for the ports
2 of Salem and Beverly shall hereafter be the same
3 as those established for outward and inward
4 bound vessels for the port of Boston.

1 SECT. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent
2 herewith are hereby repealed.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
