## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-seven.

### AN ACT

To authorize the Payment of Fees to Deputy Sheriffs and Constables for Attendance at the Probate Courts and Courts of Insolvency.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section sixty-eight of chapter one  
2 hundred and fifty-nine of the Public Statutes is  
3 hereby amended by inserting after the word  
4 "court" in the third line of said section the  
5 words "or probate court or court of insolvency,"  
6 so that said section, as amended, shall read as  
7 follows: "Deputy sheriffs and constables shall  
8 be paid out of the county treasury for attend-  
9 ance upon the supreme judicial court or the  
10 superior court, or any probate court or court of  
11 insolvency in any county except Suffolk, four dol-  
12 lars a day, and five cents a mile for travel out  
13 and home once a week during such attendance.

14 Said officers shall receive for attendance upon the  
15 supreme judicial court sitting in the county of  
16 Suffolk four dollars and fifty cents a day, and  
17 for travel the same as in other counties. Said  
18 compensation, when said court is sitting for the  
19 Commonwealth, shall be paid by the Common-  
20 wealth, and in other cases by the county."

1     SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
