### AN ACT

To authorize the City of Lawrence to reconstruct the Union Street Bridge in said City, and to borrow Money therefor.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Lawrence is hereby  
2 authorized, by a vote passed in the manner pro-  
3 vided by section seven of chapter twenty-nine of  
4 the Public Statutes, to borrow a sum of money,  
5 not exceeding seventy-five thousand dollars, for  
6 the purpose of reconstructing the Union Street  
7 Bridge, so called, over the Merrimac river in said  
8 city; and may from time to time issue negotiable  
9 bonds or certificates of indebtedness to an amount  
10 not exceeding said sum, payable in not exceeding  
11 twenty years from their date, and bearing interest  
12 at a rate not exceeding five per cent.

1   SECT. 2. The debt and loans authorized by  
2 this act shall not be included within the limit  
3 fixed by chapter three hundred and twelve of  
4 the acts of the year eighteen hundred eighty-  
5 five.

1   SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
