### AN ACT

#### Concerning Habitual Truants.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section ten of chapter forty-eight  
2 of the Public Statutes is hereby amended by in-  
3 serting after the word "ignorance," in the fifth  
4 line, the words "and such children as persistently  
5 violate the reasonable rules and regulations of the  
6 common schools"; and section twelve of said  
7 chapter is hereby amended by inserting after the  
8 word "ignorance," in the fourth line, the words  
9 "or of persistently violating the reasonable rules  
10 and regulations of the common schools."

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
