## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy-Five.

### AN ACT

To make the Seventeenth day of June, in the year eighteen hundred and seventy-five, a legal Holiday.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECT. 1. The seventeenth day of June, in the  
2 year eighteen hundred and seventy-five, is hereby  
3 made a legal public holiday, to all intents and pur-  
4 poses, in the same manner as Thanksgiving, Fast  
5 and Christmas days, the twenty-second day of  
6 February and the fourth day of July, are now  
7 by law made public holidays.

1 SECT. 2. Nothing in this act shall be construed  
2 as making said seventeenth day of June a legal  
3 holiday after said year.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect from its  
2 passage.
