

SENATE No. 172.

[House No. 297, as amended and passed by the House.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy-Five.

AN ACT

In addition to an Act for supplying the City of Fall River with pure Water.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECT. 1. The city of Fall River is authorized
2 to issue scrip, notes or certificates of debt, to be
3 denominated "Water Bonds of the City of Fall
4 River," to an amount not exceeding five hundred
5 thousand dollars, in addition to the amounts au-
6 thorized by chapter one hundred and thirty-three
7 of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and
8 seventy-one, and by chapter three hundred and
9 fifty-six of the acts of the year eighteen hundred
10 and seventy-three, and by chapter two hundred

11 and forty-four of the acts of the year eighteen
12 hundred and seventy-four.

1 SECT. 2. Said city shall each year raise by tax-
2 ation upon the polls and estates in said city, a
3 sum amounting to three per cent. of the whole
4 amount of its notes, bonds and certificates of debt
5 already issued and now outstanding, or which
6 may hereafter be issued and outstanding at the
7 close of each financial year, including the water
8 debt, which sum, with the interest and accumula-
9 tions thereon, shall constitute a sinking fund for
10 the redemption at maturity of the notes, bonds or
11 certificates of debt of said city; and said sinking
12 fund shall be appropriated, held and pledged to
13 the payment and redemption of said notes, bonds
14 and certificates of debt, and shall be used for no
15 other purpose, until the same are fully redeemed
16 and paid.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
