## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-one.

### AN ACT

To authorize the Home for Aged Men to hold Additional  
Real and Personal Estate.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows :*

1 SECTION 1. The Home for Aged Men is hereby  
2 authorized to hold real and personal estate for the  
3 purposes named in its act of incorporation, chapter  
4 one hundred and fifty-three of the Acts of eighteen  
5 hundred and sixty, to an amount not to exceed in  
6 the whole five hundred thousand dollars.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-  
2 sage.
