AN ACT

To amend "An Act fixing the Time and Place of holding Probate Courts in the County of Suffolk."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

1 SECTION 1. Section one of chapter one hundred
2 and twenty-seven of the Acts of the year eighteen
3 hundred and seventy-eight is hereby amended by
4 inserting in the third line, before the word "second,"
5 the word "first."

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
