## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-one.

### AN ACT

To amend "An Act to provide for an Associate Medical Examiner in the County of Suffolk."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :*

1 Section one of chapter fifty-nine of the Acts of  
2 the year eighteen hundred and eighty is hereby  
3 amended so as to read : —  
4 "The governor may, with the advice and consent  
5 of the council, appoint an associate medical examiner  
6 for the county of Suffolk, who shall, at the request  
7 of either of the medical examiners of said county,  
8 perform the duties and exercise the power of said  
9 medical examiner, and who shall receive an annual  
10 salary of five hundred dollars, to be paid quarterly  
11 by the treasurer of the county of Suffolk ; *provided,*  
12 that said associate medical examiner shall not be  
13 required to serve for more than one month at the

14 request of either medical examiner, and if he should  
15 so serve more than two months in any one year, he  
16 shall for such service in excess of two months be  
17 paid the same fees as are now allowed to medical  
18 examiners in counties other than Suffolk.
