AN ACT

In addition to "An Act to incorporate the Charles River Embankment Company."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The time within which the Charles River Em-
2 bankment Company is required by section five of
3 chapter two hundred and eleven of the acts of
4 the year eighteen hundred and eighty-one, to
5 deposit on the territory described in said act not
6 less than three hundred thousand cubic yards of
7 earth dredged from Charles River Basin, in such
8 localities and to such depths as the harbor and
9 land commissioners shall prescribe, is hereby ex-
10 tended to the first day of May in the year eigh-
11 teen hundred and eighty-six.
