AN ACT

Relating to Clerical Assistance in the Office of the Secretary, and for Lectures before the Board of Agriculture.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The secretary of the board of
2 agriculture may expend for other clerical ser-
3 vices in his office, and for lectures to be given be-
4 fore the board at its annual and other meetings, a
5 sum not exceeding eight hundred dollars per an-
6 num.

1 SECT. 2. So much of section four of chapter
2 twenty of the Public Statutes' as is inconsistent
3 with this act is hereby repealed.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
