### AN ACT

To establish the Salary of the Judge of Probate and  
Insolvency for the County of Suffolk.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The judge of probate and insol-  
2 vency for the county of Suffolk, from and after  
3 the first day of January, in the year eighteen hun-  
4 dred and eighty-four, shall receive an annual sal-  
5 ary of five thousand dollars.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
