AN ACT

Concerning the Fisheries in the Waters of the County
of Dukes County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section one of chapter one hun-
2 dred and two of the acts of the year eighteen
3 hundred and eighty-two is amended to read as
4 follows: —

5 “Section 1. The lessees holding from the com-
6 missioners on inland fisheries a lease of any body
7 of water in the county of Dukes County, and all
8 other persons having the right to take alewives
9 in any other waters in said county, may take ale-
10 wives from said waters, and from the ditches con-
11 necting them with each other and with the ocean,
12 at all seasons of the year and without restriction
13 as to days.”

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
