## Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-four.

### AN ACT

Repealing certain Statutes relating to the taking of Fish in the Waters of the Town and County of Nantucket.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The following statutes are hereby  
2 repealed: Chapter seventy-six of the acts of the  
3 year eighteen hundred and forty-one, authorizing  
4 the town of Nantucket to regulate the taking of  
5 fish within its limits. Chapter three hundred and  
6 thirty-seven of the acts of the year eighteen hun-  
7 dred and fifty-five, authorizing the town of Nan-  
8 tucket to regulate the fisheries in certain waters  
9 of the county of Nantucket. Chapter one hundred  
10 and eighty of the acts of the year eighteen hun-  
11 dred and seventy-five, prohibiting the seining of  
12 fish in the ponds on the island of Nantucket, and  
13 chapter forty-nine of the acts of the year eigh-  
14 teen hundred and seventy-six, relating to the sein-

15 ing of fish in Hummock Pond, on the island of  
16 Nantucket.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
