AN ACT

Relative to the Distribution of the Personal Estate
of a Husband dying Intestate, and without Kin-
dred.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Section three of chapter one hundred and thir-
2 ty-five of the Public Statutes, relating to the dis-
3 tribution of the estates of intestate persons, is
4 hereby amended, by inserting at the end of the
5 fifth clause the following clause: "If the intest-
6 ate leaves a widow and no issue nor kindred, the
7 widow shall be entitled to the whole of the resi-
8 due and."
