## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-four.

### AN ACT

In relation to the Payment of Money into the Treasury of the Commonwealth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. In all cases when sales of the  
2 property of the Commonwealth are made by any  
3 officer of a state institution, the superintendent  
4 thereof shall submit to the trustees or other su-  
5 pervising board of such institution, an itemized  
6 account of such sales, verified by his oath, which  
7 account shall be approved by the said trustees or  
8 other supervising board, in the same manner as  
9 accounts for materials and supplies for such in-  
10 stitutions are approved, and such itemized ac-  
11 count shall be filed with the treasurer of the  
12 Commonwealth, at the time the proceeds of such  
13 sales are paid into the treasury in compliance  
14 with law.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
