AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the Maintenance of the
Judicial Departments of the Government during
the Present Year.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury
3 of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
4 for the purposes specified, to meet expenses for
5 the year ending December the thirty-first, in the
6 year eighteen hundred and eighty-five, to wit:—
