RESOLVE

To provide Rooms for the Commission appointed to prepare and complete a Topographical Survey and Map of Massachusetts.

Resolved, That the Commissioners on State House be and they are hereby directed to provide suitable rooms and furnish the same, outside of the State House and Commonwealth Building, for the use of the Commission appointed to prepare and complete a contour topographical survey and map of Massachusetts. Said commissioners are authorized to expend a sum not exceeding five hundred dollars per annum for rent of said rooms, and not exceeding three hundred dollars for furnishing the same.
