### AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses at  
the State Almshouse at Tewksbury.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned  
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury  
3 of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,  
4 for the payment of salaries and current expenses  
5 at the state almshouse at Tewksbury, during the  
6 year eighteen hundred and eighty-five, to wit:—  
7 For salaries, wages and labor at the state alms-  
8 house at Tewksbury, a sum not exceeding  
9 twenty-one thousand dollars; and for current  
10 expenses at said institution, a sum not exceeding  
11 seventy-five thousand dollars. [Pub. Stat., chap.  
12 86.]

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
