## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-five.

### AN ACT

To incorporate the Somerville Savings Bank.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Selwyn Z. Bowman, Silas H. Hol-  
2 land, Robert A. Vinal, Charles S. Lincoln, Oren  
3 S. Knapp, Philip Eberlee, Josiah Q. Bennett,  
4 and Edwin B. Buckingham, their associates and  
5 successors, are hereby made a corporation by the  
6 name of the Somerville Savings Bank, to be  
7 located in the city of Somerville, with all the  
8 powers and privileges and subject to all the  
9 duties, liabilities and restrictions set forth in all  
10 general laws which now are, or may hereafter  
11 be, in force relating to savings banks and insti-  
12 tutions for savings.

1 SECT. 2. Chapter seventy-four of the acts and  
2 resolves of the year one thousand eight hundred

3 and seventy is hereby repealed, and the corpora-  
4 tion known as the Somerville Savings Bank or-  
5 ganized under said act is hereby dissolved.

1    SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
