### AN ACT

To confirm Certain Acts of the Plumb Island Turnpike and Bridge Corporation.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Transfers of stock in the Plumb  
2 Island Turnpike and Bridge Corporation, incor-  
3 porated by act approved February twenty-fourth,  
4 in the year eighteen hundred and six, shall not be  
5 required to be made under seal nor to be ac-  
6 knowledged; and no transfer of its stock hereto-  
7 fore made shall be deemed invalid solely because  
8 such transfer was not under seal or not ac-  
9 knowledged.

1 SECT. 2. No meeting of said corporation here-  
2 tofore held, and no proceeding, act, election or  
3 vote of such meeting, and no contract, deed, issue  
4 or transfer of stock authorized by or accepted at

5 such meeting, shall be deemed invalid because  
6 any person or persons acted as officers or stock-  
7 holders at said meeting who held stock by trans-  
8 fers not under seal or not acknowledged and  
9 recorded.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
