AN ACT

To enable Cities and Towns to lease their Public Buildings or part thereof Posts of the "Grand Army of the Republic."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Cities and towns are authorized to lease for a
- 2 period not exceeding five years, to any post of
- 3 the "Grand Army of the Republic" established
- 4 therein, any of their public buildings or part
- 5 thereof.
