### AN ACT

To confirm the Proceedings of Certain Town Meetings of the Town of Grafton.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The proceedings of the annual  
2 meeting of the town of Grafton, held March sec-  
3 ond, in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-  
4 five, and the adjourned meetings thereof, shall not  
5 be invalid for the reason that tellers were not ap-  
6 pointed and sworn according to law, to aid in  
7 checking the names of voters, and in sorting and  
8 counting the votes; and the election of town offi-  
9 cers and other doings of said meetings are hereby  
10 ratified and confirmed.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
