In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-five.

AN ACT

Relative to the Payment of Operatives by Manufacturing Corporations at Intervals not exceeding Fourteen Days.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. All manufacturing corporations
2 shall] pay, at intervals not exceeding fourteen
3 days, all operatives employed by them the wages
4 earned by such operatives to within six days of
5 the date of said payments.

1 SECT. 2. Any manufacturing corporation wil-
2 fully violating the provisions of this act shall be

3 punished by a fine not exceeding fifty dollars and
4 not less than twenty dollars.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect on the first
2 day of July in the year eighteen hundred and
3 eighty-five.
