AN ACT

Relating to Clerical Assistance in the Office of the Register of Probate and Insolvency in the County of Middlesex.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The register of probate and
2 insolvency for the county of Middlesex shall be
3 allowed a sum not exceeding fifteen hundred dol-
4 lars per annum, from and after the first day of
5 April in the year one thousand eight hundred and
6 eighty-five, for clerical assistance actually per-
7 formed, in addition to the amount now allowed by
8 law, to be paid from the treasury of the Common-
9 wealth upon the official certificate of the judge of
10 probate and insolvency for said county.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
