### AN ACT

To repeal "An Act to empower the inhabitants of the town of Plymouth to choose a Board of Health, and for removing and preventing nuisances in said town."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The Act entitled "An Act to  
2 empower the inhabitants of the town of Plymouth  
3 to choose a Board of Health, and for removing  
4 and preventing nuisances in said town," approved  
5 February twenty-seventh, in the year eighteen  
6 hundred and ten, is repealed.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
