AN ACT

To Increase the Salary of the Constables of the
Municipal Court of the City of Boston for
Criminal Business.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Each of the constables designated
2 to attend the sessions of the municipal court of
3 the city of Boston for criminal business shall re-
4 ceive an annual salary of fifteen hundred dollars,
5 instead of thirteen hundred, as now provided by
6 chapter two hundred forty-five, section one, of
7 the acts of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-
8 two.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
