AN ACT

Relating to the Salary of the Clerk of the Police Court of Gloucester.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section sixty-four of chapter one
2 hundred and fifty-four of the Public Statutes is
3 amended so that the salary of the clerk of the
4 police court of Gloucester shall be eight hundred
5 dollars a year.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
