## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-three.

### AN ACT

Prohibiting Railroad Corporations to require Women and Children to ride in regular Smoking-cars.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. No railroad corporation doing  
2 business within this Commonwealth shall compel  
3 or require women or children to ride in the regu-  
4 lar smoking-cars of the company.

1 SECT. 2. Any violation of this act shall be  
2 punished by a fine of not less than ten or more  
3 than fifty dollars.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
