AN ACT

Giving to the Widow of a Deceased Proprietor of a Cemetery Lot the Right of Interment in such Lot.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Lots in cemeteries shall, upon the
2 decease of a proprietor, descend to his heirs at
3 law, or to the devisees of such lot if devised, sub-
4 ject to a right of interment of the widow of such
5 proprietor, for her own body, in the lot in which
6 said proprietor shall be buried.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
