AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Norton to receive and hold certain Property in Trust.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Norton is hereby
2 authorized to receive from Cyrus Hicks, of Bos-
3 ton, the sum of four thousand dollars, the same
4 to be forever held in trust, for the following pur-
5 poses, to wit: one half of the income of said
6 fund shall be used to keep in repair the burial lot
7 of the said Cyrus Hicks, situate in the centre
8 burial ground in Norton, and the other half of
9 said income shall be appropriated by said town
10 towards defraying its ordinary expenses.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
