Acting Governor Karyn Polito's Schedule for Wednesday, July 26, 2017

BOSTON – Tomorrow, Acting Governor Karyn Polito will chair a weekly meeting of the Governor’s Council. She will then join Brockton Mayor Bill Carpenter to announce Brownfields Redevelopment Fund awards to support the environmental assessment and cleanup of contaminated and challenging sites across the Commonwealth.

[Last year, Governor Baker signed comprehensive economic development legislation](#), authorizing \$45 million in capital funding for the Brownfields Redevelopment Fund. This Fund is part of the administration’s focus on the economic vitality of communities, unlocking economic growth in all regions of the Commonwealth. Since its inception in 1998, the Brownfields Redevelopment Fund has helped to transform vacant, abandoned, or underutilized industrial or commercial properties.

Later, the Lt. Governor will join State Senator Michael Rodrigues, Representative Paul Schmid and local leaders to tour the Westport Town Landing. The tour will highlight the Seaport Economic Council’s \$249,000 investment into the landing, funding rehabilitation of the entire parcel by restoring historic features, improving public amenities and increasing handicap accessibility, parking, lighting and seating.
