DECISION

A Commission hearing was held to determine whether H&S Farah Enterprises, LLC d.b.a. Rock Pond Restaurant violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: Ch. 138 §34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age (1 count).

The licensee stipulated to the facts contained in the Investigator's report dated April 16, 2009.

The Investigator's Compliance Check Field Report states an underage operative, d.o.b. 4/14/1992, working with A.B.C.C. Investigators purchased a Bud Light beer for \$3.00 at the Rock Pond Restaurant. The young woman was not asked for identification by the bartender prior to being served.

The Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: Ch. 138 §34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age (1 count) and, therefore, **suspends the license for 3 days of which 3 days will be held in abeyance for a period of two years provided no further violation of Ch. 138 or Commission regulations occur.**
