DECISION

A Commission hearing was held to determine whether Bridge Street Pizzeria, Inc. d.b.a. Bridge Street Pizzeria & Sports Bar violated Ch. 138 §23- Sale of Alcoholic Beverages other than those purchased from a licensee under section 18 or 19 or from a holder of a special permit under section 22A (3 counts).

The licensee stipulated to the facts contained in the Investigator's report dated July 21, 2009.

The report states on Monday, July 20, 2009 an A.B.C.C. Investigator inspected the business operation of Bridge Street Pizzeria, Inc. He found three bottles of alcoholic beverages with package store labels affixed to them. The bottles were as follows: 1 bottle of JB Scotch Whiskey; 1 bottle of Corbet Canyon Cabernet; and, 1 bottle of Beefeater Dry Gin.

The Commission finds the licensee in violation of Ch. 138 §23- Sale of Alcoholic Beverages other than those purchased from a licensee under section 18 or 19 or from a holder of a special permit under section 22A (3 counts) and, **suspends the license for 3 days of which 3 days will be held in abeyance for 2 years provided no further violations of Ch. 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**
